

Eligibility Criteria

In order to participate in TechSoup Nigeria programs and services, an organization must be validated as an organization operating on a nonprofit basis for the public benefit.

In order to successfully complete the validation review in Nigeria, an organization must be:

- Organizations must be funds, bodies, or institutions listed under the Fifth Schedule of the Companies Income Tax Act (CITA) or engaged in activities introduced with the Amendment of the Fifth Schedule and certified by the Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS) to receive tax-deductible donations. (Note: Although many legal forms may be tax-exempt, only associations with incorporated trustees and companies limited by guarantee are eligible.)

In order to validate your organization, you will need to provide sufficient evidence that your organization holds the above status. This may include a certificate of registration or incorporation, inclusion in an official government registry or database, and/or a copy of your organization's governing documents.

The following are requisite:

1. A copy of your Certificate of Incorporation showing that you are registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission
2. A copy of the organisation's governing documents or the By-Law.
3. A letter signed from the organisation's Executive Director attesting that you are a member of the organisation and are authorised to register the organisation on Techsoup. Kindly note that the letter must be printed on the organisation's official letterhead and must be submitted in one of the following formats: PDF, JPG, GIF, or PNG.

A designated TechSoup representative will review the provided details and determine if the registered organization meets the requirements established in the localized definition.

Please note that validated organizations are also subject to any additional eligibility criteria required by specific programs or service offerings being applied for.
